## PhD Chemistry Research Proposal Sample

**Abstract**

The spectra for carbon-13 nuclear magnetic resonance (CMR) shows a determined sensitivity to important aspects of chemical structure such as heteroatom electronegativity, carbon hybridization, steric crowding and branching. In perspective, CMR can be considered as a rich resource for structural data in the field of organic chemistry, with its capability to rival or even surpass proton magnetic resonance. In this research proposal, it is our intention to develop this specific potential in steroid chemistry.

The factors that determine this spectra of steroids have been modestly understood only. We have already started with the initial phase, and propose to continue working on a systematic approach involving families of closely tied steroids with the belief that only through the completion of a systematic study can the factors that govern the CMR spectra be called into surface and understood accordingly. We also intend to quantify these mentioned factors, classifying them as predictive rules relating to structure spectra, and in developing different computerized means for using and applying these rules in order to extract potential structural data from the CMR spectra involving unknown steroids. We also include in this proposal the possibility of developing various derivatization procedures and chemical methods for enhancing the information content of this spectra.

**Background**

During the last two decades, the phenomenon involving nuclear magnetic resonance has somewhat changed, starting from laboratory curiosity, leading up to the most recognized analytical tools in the field of chemistry. The experiment involves observation, in an applied magnetic field, with the resonance frequencies applied in a sample of liquid chemical. The analysis which respectively reflects the chemical environments and the spatial relationships or bonding between the atoms with magnetic nuclei.

**Objective of the Research**

The proposed research is directed with the goal of understanding the different factors which determines C-13 chemical shifts with steroids, leading towards the development of computer based methods, wherein a chemist can easily obtain enough structural details from the spectra of a number of unknown steroids. This compound class was selected for two main reasons. One, the skeleton steroid is less rigid offering a controlled framework within the effects involving steric hindrance, as well as other geometrical factors are involved with C-13 shifts. Second, a huge fraction of the steroid and natural products of chemistry includes the verification or identification of these steroid structures, and thus expecting the results to be significant, especially when it comes to practical use.
